Dear Parade Entrant:

Thank you for submitting your application for the inaugural Veterans Day parade. The parade will be held on Thursday, November 11, 2021, and will begin promptly at 10:00am. We anticipate a fun and enjoyable event this year. To make certain you follow parade guidelines, please read, and follow the instructions listed below and those detailed on your parade application.

- **All entrants, other than equestrian entries**, will pick up your parade number and check in at the official's area located at the southeast corner of Beaumont Avenue and Cyrise Lane. If you are a group entry, please send **one person only** to pick up your number and check in.
- **All bands and marching groups**, please travel north from 6th Street on Euclid Avenue to 12th Street and turn right to your staging area, located in the Weaver Mortuary parking lot, where you will receive your parade number. The address of Weaver Mortuary is 1177 Beaumont Avenue.
- **Equestrians, including horses, ponies, horse drawn wagons, carts, carriages, etc.**, should park at the corner of 7th Street and Magnolia Avenue, where you will receive your parade number. After judging, please move your entry north to 12th Street and Beaumont Avenue. You will locate your line-up number on East 12th Street.
- **Distribution of items to parade spectators** – due to safety concerns, NO ITEMS (including water and candy) may be thrown to parade spectators from vehicles. All items MUST BE HANDED to the parade spectators by participants walking along the sides of the road.

All entrants must be in your assigned parade position by 9:30am sharp. If you are not in your assigned parade position, you may be moved to the end of the parade route. Forward motion must be maintained throughout the entire parade route. We have enclosed a map that shows the parade lineup area.

The parade will disband at 6th Street and Maple Avenue. Because this area can become ***extremely congested***, we ask that you adhere to the following information and share it with all your participants prior to Thursday's parade:

- **All bands and marching groups** will be directed north on Maple Avenue to the Palm Elementary school parking lot to disband. After disbanding, your group will leave the area via 7th Street east to Palm Avenue.
- **All floats and tractors** will be directed north on Maple Avenue and will disband along either side of 7th Street. After disbanding, your group will leave the area via 7th Street east to Palm Avenue.
- **Equestrian groups** will be directed north on Maple Avenue, east on 7th Street and north on Palm Avenue to 8th Street. From there, you will proceed west on 8th Street to your staging area.
- **Motorized vehicles** (including cars, trucks, fire engines, etc.) will be directed south on Maple Avenue to 5th Street, then either east to Palm Avenue or west to Beaumont Avenue to disband.

There will be a short **Salute to Veterans** ceremony at approximately 11:00am at the Beaumont Civic Center, located at 550 East 6th Street, in the front lawn area. Please plan to attend the ceremony and join your community in honoring those Veterans that have served our nation in the armed forces.

Thank you for your participation and we look forward to an outstanding parade!
