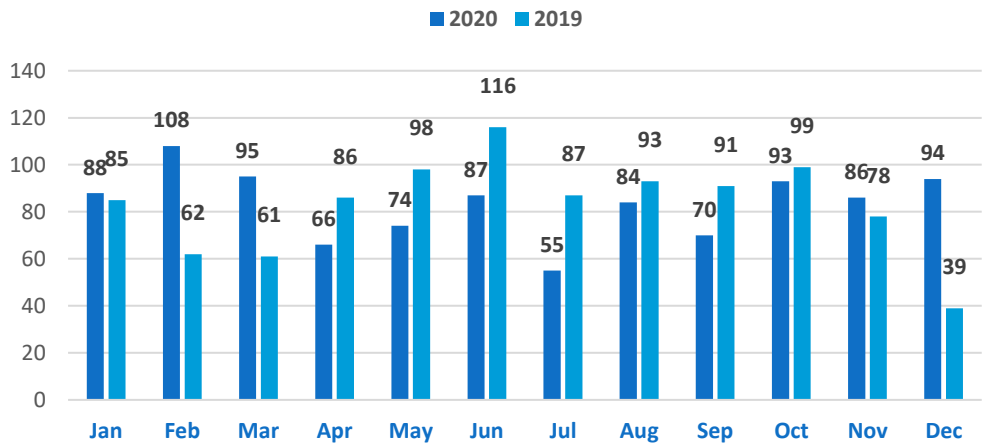
## Crime Statistics - 2020

The Beaumont Police Department anticipated an increase in crime in 2020 and was trending that way in the first three months of the year.

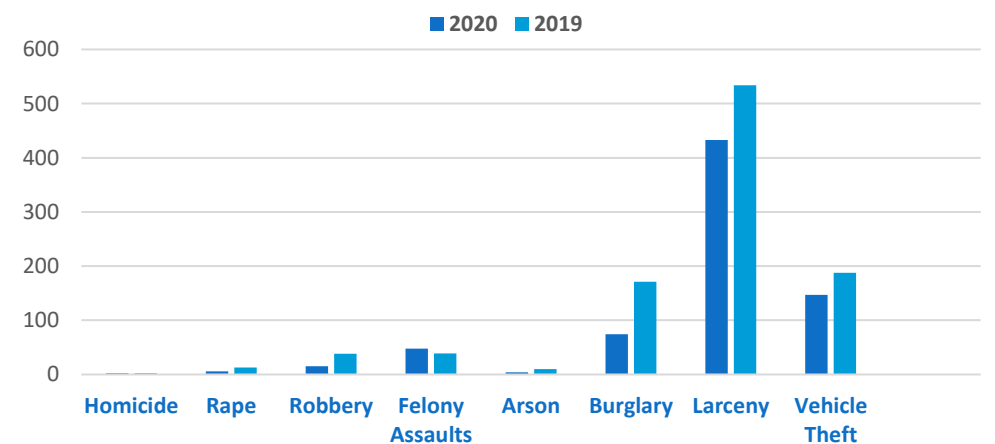
Once the pandemic hit, there was a decrease across the board in almost every area.

As our County and State begins to open back up and get back to some normalcy, we expect greater calls for service and these number to rise.

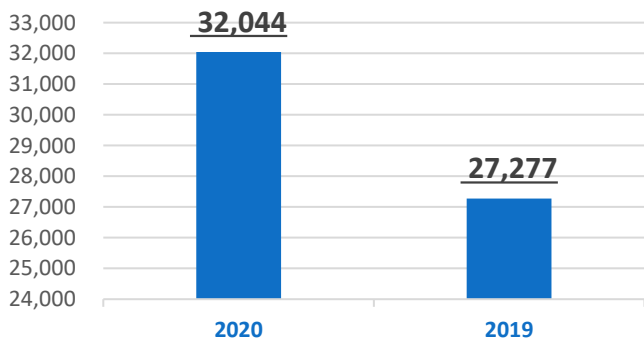
### PART 1 CRIMES MONTHLY TOTALS



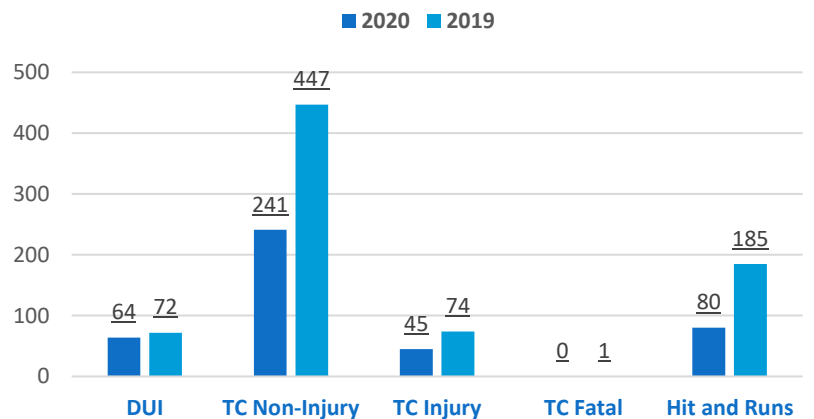
### PART 1 CRIMES CATEGORIES

## Department Enforcement Efforts



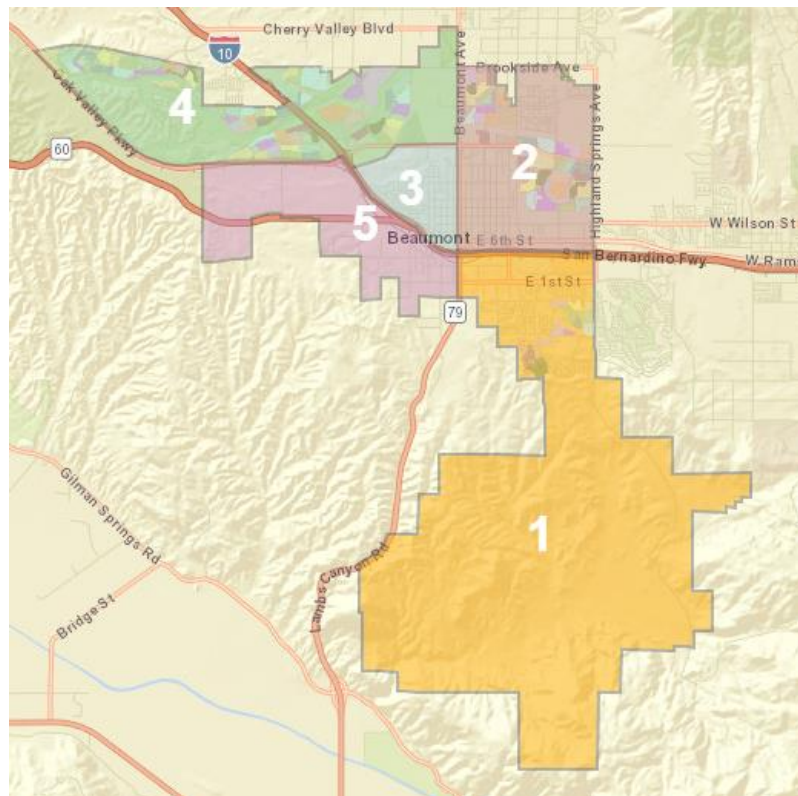
- Daily focus on our mission of crime reductions, traffic enforcement and quality of life issues.

## Beaumont Police Department Beat System

In police terminology, a **'beat'** is the territory or geographical area a police officer patrols. Beat policing is a form of community policing, which utilizes the close relationship with the community members within the assigned beat to strengthen police effectiveness and encourage cooperative efforts to make a safer community.

The Beaumont Police Department has a five beat system that distributes officers throughout the city.
