Independent Registered Municipal Advisor Exemption

By publicly posting the following written disclosure, the City of Beaumont intends that market participants may receive and use it for purposes of qualifying for the independent registered municipal advisor exemption to the U. S. Securities and Exchange Commission Municipal Advisor Rule (in accordance with Section 15B(e)(4)(c) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934) until December 31, 2025 or until otherwise withdrawn or replaced by the Issuer.

The City of Beaumont has retained an independent registered municipal advisor. The City of Beaumont is represented by and will rely on the firm of Urban Futures, Inc. to, among other things, advise the City of Beaumont (including its Financing Authority) regarding proposals from financial services firms concerning the issuance of municipal securities and municipal financial products (including investments of bond proceeds and escrow investments).

If the proposal received will be seriously considered by the City of Beaumont, the City will share the document with Urban Futures, Inc. Please note that, aside from the regulatory mandated correspondence between an underwriter and municipal advisor, underwriters should not speak directly with or send documents directly to Urban Futures, Inc. unless specifically directed to by the City of Beaumont.
