City of Beaumont Deputy City Clerk Receives Title of Master Municipal Clerk

Beaumont, CA—Deputy City Clerk Nicole Wheelwright has earned the designation of Master Municipal Clerk (MMC) by the International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC), Inc. IIMC grants the MMC designation to municipal clerks who complete demanding education requirements and have significant contributions to their local government, community, and state.

Nicole was appointed to Deputy City Clerk in January 2016 and became a member of the California Clerks Association (CCA). To obtain your MMC, Nicole had to first complete 350 hours of education to obtain the Certified Municipal Clerk (CMC) designation. From 2018-2023, Nicole contributed 260 hours towards training other clerks in their certification journey, mentoring others, and leading projects beyond the standard scope of her duties. Nicole was instrumental in implementing the city's Public, Education, and Government (PEG) Channel featured on Channel 32 on Frontier Cable, the renovation of Council Chambers, and ADA accommodation. Prior to her role as Deputy City Clerk, Nicole served various roles within the city with a focus on customer service.

Upon designation, IIMC President Mary Ann Hess, MMC wrote “In light of the speed and drastic nature of change these days, lifelong learning is not only desirable, it is necessary for all in local governments...”
